## OUR VEHICLE

The new Rhody Express vehicle (to arrive in 2010) is an Aerotech 240, with capacity for 16 people seated facing forward. There is also room for one wheelchair on the vehicle. The farebox is conveniently located by the driver, just inside the front door. Seats in the front of the bus are designated for seniors and people with disabilities.

## USING ASSISTIVE DEVICES ON THE RHODY EXPRESS

The Rhody Express vehicle is wheelchair accessible and has room for two wheelchairs. The driver is available to assist with wheelchair boarding and securement.

If you have difficulty getting to the bus along our fixed route, and you are within two blocks of the bus route, it is possible to request that the bus make a short deviation in order to assist you. Such deviations, either for pick-up or drop-off, must be requested in advance by calling the Rhody Express operator at: 541-902-2067 (voice – a local Florence number) or 800-735-2900 (TTY – Oregon Relay).

## RHODY DIAL-A-RIDE

The Rhody Dial-a-Ride service provides curb-to-curb transportation for people traveling within Florence who are unable to use the regular Rhody Express bus service because of their disability. Eligible riders can travel to and from any location that falls within approximately three-quarters of a mile of the Rhody Express bus route.

Rhody Dial-a-Ride Service is available Monday through Friday from 10 AM to 6 PM. Rides must be prescheduled through the RideSource Call Center, and may be grouped for efficiency. The fare is \$2 per person for each one-way ride.

To determine eligibility, for the Rhody Dial-a-Ride service, you must fill out an application and complete an in-person interview with Senior and Disabled Service. The Rhody Express does not operate on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas Day



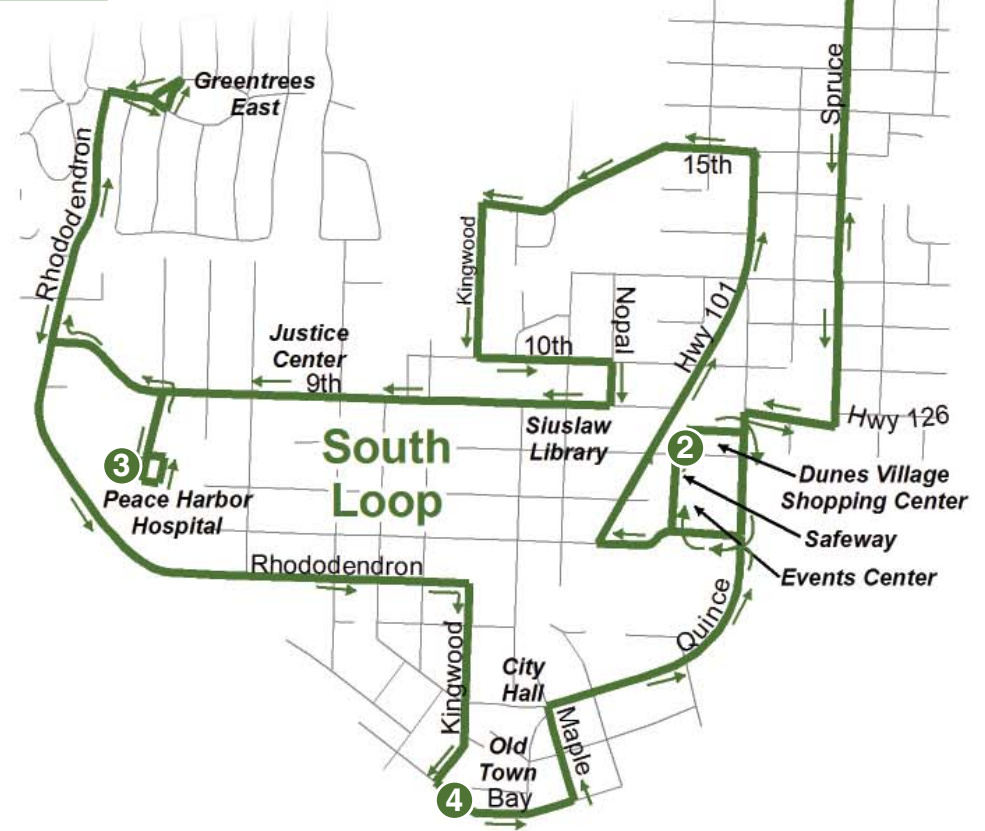

One vehicle runs first the South Loop and then the North Loop. If the origin and destination of your trip are on different loops, just stay on the bus. Times in the schedules shown above are approximate due to possible short diversions by the bus.

### HOW TO CATCH THE BUS

You may board the bus at any safe location along our route; however, we cannot make stops along U.S. 101. Please stand on the correct side of the street when boarding the bus. The bus only picks up at curbside in the direction shown on the map.
