Construction Moves Forward This Spring

West Eugene EmX is on track to start serving passengers in fall 2017! To keep things moving along, construction resumed in February by adding a right-turn lane on West Sixth Avenue at Chambers Street. Next, crews will begin work on Garfield Street and West 11th Avenue, west of Bailey Hill Road. Construction will alternate between roads and sidewalks to reduce traffic impacts and keep pedestrian access open. Work on West 11th Avenue, between Bailey Hill Road and Garfield is expected to happen in Spring 2017.

Say Thank You on Friday, March 18


