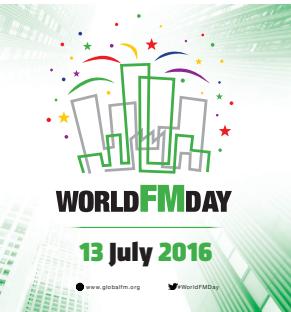

JULY COMMUNITY EVENTS

July 1–10: Olympic Track and Field Trials

The Olympic Trials will be held July 1–10 at Hayward Field. To help people access the events, EmX service will run even more frequently during a three hour window at the end of daily events.

- On weekdays during the trials, July 1 and 5–8, EmX will run every 10 minutes during the day and increase to every 7–8 minutes at the end of trial events.
- On Saturdays during the trials, July 2 and 9, EmX will run every 15 minutes during the day and increase to every 7–8 minutes at the end of trial events.
- On Sundays during the trials, July 3–4 (due to the Fourth of July holiday) and 10, EmX will run every 30 minutes during the day and increase to every 15 minutes at the end of trial events.

Event ticket holders, participants, volunteers and staff may ride free on all LTD routes June 30–July 10 courtesy of TrackTown USA. July 4: Butte To Butte

Take a free shuttle to the starting line of Eugene’s most popular road race, the Butte To Butte, courtesy of the Oregon Track Club.

- Routes 970 & 971X will pick up passengers at the bus stops at 5th/Pearl and 4th/Mill
- Shuttles depart every 5–10 minutes, 6:30–7:40 a.m.

July 8–10: Oregon Country Fair

Head to the 47th Annual Oregon Country Fair via shuttle to avoid parking fees and hassles. The shuttle and fares on the entire LTD system are free for the weekend, July 8–10.

- Route 988X will pick up passengers at Eugene Station Bay I every 15–20 minutes, 10 a.m.–6:15 p.m.
- Route 989X will pick up passengers at Valley River Center Park & Ride (Northwest Corner behind Eugene Crossfit) every 15–20 minutes, 10 a.m.–6:15 p.m.
- The last bus returning to both locations will leave the Oregon Country Fair at 7:30 p.m.

Tickets for the Oregon Country Fair must be purchased in advance of boarding the shuttle. There are no ticket sales at the fair. Tickets may be purchased at TicketsWest outlets, online at [TicketsWest.com](https://www.ticketswest.com), by calling 1-800-992-8499 or on the day of the event at the Valley River Center Park & Ride.

Bicycle racks are available at both shuttle locations. However, space is limited at Eugene Station, so please plan accordingly. Visit [OregonCountryFair.org](https://www.oregoncountryfair.org) to learn more about the event and transportation options.



July 21: Touch-a-Truck 5–7:30 p.m., Petersen Barn Community Center

A fun family event designed for children to look at, crawl on and sit in community “Big Rigs.” An LTD bus will be there for everyone to explore. Route 40 Echo Hollow has a stop two blocks from the event and stops there every 30 minutes.

July 30: Willamalane Children’s Celebration 10 a.m.–3 p.m., Island Park in Springfield

Hands-on activities for children will be available from more than 60 community exhibitors. Entrance to the event is free with a canned food donation supporting FOOD for Lane County.

July 31: Eugene Sunday Streets 12–4 p.m., Broadway Street from Kesey Square to Monore Park & Park Blocks in Downtown Eugene

Eugene Sunday Streets promotes active transportation by making the city’s largest public spaces and streets, car-free for an afternoon. The event will feature several miles of a traffic-free streets, allowing people to walk, bike and roll through downtown. Activity centers like free fitness classes, dancing, yoga, slacklining and live music will be located throughout the event.

SNAG A CARSHARE MEMBERSHIP

An Easy and Affordable Transportation Option

Carshare is a membership based program that provides an alternative to car ownership by offering easy-to-access rental vehicles by the hour. With 24-hour access to vehicles, carsharing allows for the travel freedom of car-ownership, but costs far less than owning and maintaining a personal vehicle.

Enterprise CarShare has cars available in Eugene and Springfield for use by the hour, day and overnight trips. Members simply reserve and choose the nearest vehicle online, then return it to the same location when finished. Fuel, insurance and maintenance costs are included in the \$5-8 hourly rate.
