#### 2016 Ridership Exceeds 2015

In July, 24,621 people rode LTD's Butte To Butte and Oregon Country Fair Express Routes. These figures outpace 2015 by nearly 1,500 rides! Each year we work with event organizers to help get people to these Lane County classics in efforts to reduce traffic congestion and carbon emissions.

We also have a third event service route, the Autzen Express, which takes people to Autzen Stadium for large events. The Autzen Express runs from eight Park & Ride locations every 10 minutes. For University of Oregon home football games, service begins four hours before kickoff, and provides return trips at halftime and for 60 minutes after the game. ## More Service Beginning Sept. 18

This fall we're making buses more frequent and expanding hours of operation on Sundays. In total, we're adding 14,000 service hours, a 5 percent increase in service!
