The EmX makes stops along Franklin Blvd (in front of the Matthew Knight Arena), and at Dad's Gates (a block and a half east of NCU's Morse Sports Complex) and connects to many LTD bus routes for Duck and Beacon fans traveling into the urban area. Cash and credit cards are accepted at EmX fareboxes and all bus passes can be used on EmX.

Starts January 2017



Lane Transit District is one of these organizations. LTD provides free rides to those who express interest in being sheltered at an Egan Warming Center. To receive a free ride to an Egan Warming Center, talk to your driver. The Egan program is administered by St. Vincent de Paul Society of Lane County. 
