This month, the orange construction cones are going away, plants are being planted, and final touches are being completed. In preparation for the September 17 launch of the new EmX line, you may begin seeing EmX buses traveling up and down the west-side corridor as LTD drivers are in training for the new route. These buses on West Eugene streets are not yet in service, but will be in mid-September!

Bridges mean better community access

On Saturday, June 24, LTD announced the grand opening of the Buck Street Pedestrian-Bicycle Bridge in West Eugene. The Buck Street Bridge is one of three bike-ped bridges that are part of the West Eugene EmX project. With the addition of the Buck, Commerce and Quaker Street bridges along the Fern Ridge Path, it is now safer and more convenient for residents and west-side travelers to access West 11th destinations and meet their transit connection.



BE SAFE THIS SUMMER

Take care when biking and walking



Summer is here, school is out, and people are enjoying walking and biking in our community. Both the cities of Eugene and Springfield have installed many new safety features including stutter flash crossing signals, bike boxes, buffered bike lanes and more to improve bicycle and pedestrian safety in our area.

Additional tips to keep you safe:

- Wear bright or reflective clothing and reflectors/lights in early morning and at night.
- Make eye contact with the driver before crossing the street.
- Plan extra time to get to your destination so you have enough time to get there safely.
- Show a light so bus drivers can see you at your stop when waiting for the bus in low visibility situations.
