
AUTZEN EXPRESS IS BACK!

Return trips on these express buses are available for one hour after the game. Round trip fare is \$3.50 for adults and \$1.75 age 18 and younger. All LTD passes are also accepted as fare. EmX in west Eugene is one of the largest public works project in the regions' history. As part of the project, improvements were made that benefit both the environment and the community. Improvements include:

- 6 miles of road improvements
- 5 miles of improved and new sidewalks
- 2 signalized pedestrian crossings
- 3 pedestrian-bike bridges
- 200 trees gained
- 35 water filtration planters
- 6 rain gardens

What's new

Riders and community members have asked for better connections and faster travel through west Eugene. That vision becomes a reality this month when LTD makes several route changes in west Eugene, including the EmX West route, to increase connectivity, reduce travel times, and add transfer options for riders.

This is one of the largest service enhancements in LTD's history. LTD understands that riders will need assistance and will have questions. Here are ways to get the information you need:

Service changes in west Eugene

EmX (Weekday/Saturday/Sunday)

- New routing to West 11th using Charnelton, 6th and 7th
- Major stop additions for all trips

32 W 1st (Weekday)

Route removed and replaced with Route 93
 and EmX

36 W 18th (Weekday/Saturday/Sunday)

- Route no longer serves Arrowsmith and Terry
- Major stop changes for all trips
- The 11:45 p.m. weekday trip ends at 11th and Commerce (Walmart)

41 Barger/Commerce (Weekday/Saturday/Sunday)

- Route no longer serves 8th Avenue, but instead serves 11th to Garfield
- Route ends at West 11th and Commerce (Walmart)
- Route leaves from Bay C at Eugene Station
- Major stop changes for all weekday, Saturday, and Sunday trips
- The 11:45 p.m. weekday trip will end at 11th and Commerce

43 W 11th/Barger (Weekday/Saturday/Sunday)

Route removed and replaced with Route 41
 and EmX

55 North Park (Weekday)

- Route uses 11th/13th to Garfield
- Route leaves from Bay A at Eugene Station
- Major stop changes for all trips

76 UO/Warren (Weekday)

Route removed and replaced with Route 78
 and EmX

78 UO/Seneca/Warren (Weekday)

- Route serves Wilshire and Warren area as well as Oakpatch
- Major stop changes for all weekday trips

93 Veneta (Weekday/Saturday/Sunday)

- Route will start and end at Seneca Park & Ride
- Veneta loop will operate in one direction only (the current p.m. routing)
- Two trips added on weekdays, one on Saturday, and two trips now operate on Sundays

Pull the cord or push the button

EmX riders will now need to either pull the cord or push the red button at the doors to request a stop. Beginning Sept. 17, EmX buses will only stop at major stations, upon passenger request, or where riders are waiting to board. This enables EmX to provide a quicker, smoother ride by not stopping at stations that do not require it.
