



On April 19, PeaceHealth Rides launched the new Bike Share service in Eugene with 35 Stations throughout Eugene and UO campus. Bike Share is a great way to help people get around without using a vehicle. Whether you rode the bus downtown and need to get around to nearby places, or just want a quick bike ride on your lunch hour, Bike Share is a great solution.

It's easy! Sign up, check out a bike from any of the 35 stations, ride, and return to any station. All for a low fee structured by whether you are an occasional or frequent user of the service.

Bike Share was brought to the community in partnership with the City of Eugene, University of Oregon, and Lane Transit District. The program is similar to other popular Bike Share services that are being used in many cities across the U.S. and elsewhere.

MAY WALK & BIKE TO SCHOOL

Walk + Roll in May

May 9 is National Bike to School Day and schools around the country are celebrating by participating in events that get kids actively walking, biking and rolling to school. Thousands of kids and hundreds of schools across the nation participate including here in our community!

The Eugene-Springfield region is lucky to have a network of school communities that value the benefits of active transportation. More than 30 elementary and middle schools in the 4J, Bethel and Springfield school districts will participate locally in the Walk+Roll

Challenge. The Walk+Roll Challenge is a fun, month-long competition aimed at encouraging more kids and families to walk, bike and roll to and from school. Participating schools are organizing activities and events that will challenge families to consider a car-free way to school.

Last year, students, ages 6-18 from 34 schools in the Eugene-Springfield area logged almost 12,000 walking, biking, bus riding or carpooling trips during the challenge. Wow!

The Walk+Roll Challenge is organized by volunteers from within our local school communities. We couldn't do it without them! Point2point at Lane Transit District is helping support these events by marketing the Walk+Roll Challenge and contributing incentives to participating schools.
