Carpool Basics

When two or more people of legal driving age share a ride, they are carpooling! While carpooling has many



benefits to our community, like reducing CO2 pollution and traffic congestion, it also helps the individual employee to:

- 1. Save at least 50% on daily commute costs like gas, vehicle wear and tear, and parking.
- 2. Reduce stress by sharing time spent behind-the-wheel.
- 3. Build community with co-workers and neighbors.

How to Start

As an ETC, you can help your fellow employees find co-workers to carpool with by giving them these instructions:

- Log into GetThereOregon.org, click on the Dashboard tab, and add details about your route and schedule preferences under "My Commutes".
- 2. Click on "Carpool Options". A map will appear showing other commuters' starting and ending points.
- 3. If you find a match, click "Connect" to communicate your interest in ridesharing.



If you are looking for some lower-tech methods for ride-matching, you could:

- Create an excel file for your company intranet
- Provide bulletin board space for employees to print and post a Carpool Wanted Flyer or
- Host a carpool matching lunch or other event.

Facilitating Carpooling

To help make carpooling easier and more attractive for your co-workers, you can:

- 1. Provide some Carpool Tips.
- 2. Ask your employer to designate priority parking spaces for employees who carpool and order carpool parking signs for those spaces.
