### **Transit Basics**

Public transportation in the Eugene-Springfield area is provided by Lane Transit District (LTD) via fixed route and rapid transit Emerald Express (EmX) buses. Public transit not only lowers a commuter's carbon footprint and traffic congestion, it also:

- 1. Saves money on commute costs like gas, vehicle wear and tear, and parking (especially if the employer is part of the Group Pass Program).
- 2. Reduces stress by allowing LTD do the driving. Commuters can use the extra time to do other tasks or simply relax.
- 3. Builds community with like-minded people who also use transit.

#### **How to Start**

ETCs can help their co-workers get started with riding the bus by passing along information about:

- System Basics: Direct co-workers to LTD's website for information on riding basics, EmX basics, fare pricing information, and bus rules.
- 2. Trip Planning: Print the Mobile Trip Planning flyer or give them our Commute Planner and send it in to point2point@LTD.org.

### **Facilitating Transit**

To help make taking transit easier and more attractive for your co-workers, you can:

- 1. Remind employees about Park & Ride locations as a convenient place to catch the bus.
- 2. If you are not a part of the Group Pass Program, request free day passes from LTD so co-workers can try transit at no cost.
- 3. If not already enrolled, advocate to your employer about LTD's Group Pass Program.
