[Company Name] is pleased to announce a new benefit that should be of interest to all employees who've ever considered carpooling, vanpooling, busing, walking, or biking to work to save money and reduce commute stress.

In cooperation with Point2point at Lane Transit District, we are offering a free Emergency Ride Home (ERH) program. This program will provide a free taxi ride for any employee who has used a means other than driving alone to work and has an emergency which requires them to leave work.

It's easy to use ERH. **Do not wait until you have an emergency to register!** You must be signed up in advance to use this program.

1. Create an account and join your employer network at <http://www.getthereoregon.org>.
2. When you need to access the Emergency Ride Home program, simply log into your account at GetThereOregon.org, and click on Programs > Rewards > Emergency Ride Home Program to redeem a voucher. Participating taxi providers are listed on the voucher.

That's all there is to it. You'll provide the voucher to the taxi company who will then bill Point2point directly.

Please note that there is a limit of four rides per employee per calendar year.

We hope that this new program will give you peace of mind and allow you to use transportation options whenever possible.
