

SINGLE RIDE TICKETS HAVE A NEW LOOK!

Riders using **10-Ride Ticket** books will now have a new **Single Ride Ticket** featuring a scanable QR code.

ONE TICKET = Single Ride TWO TICKETS = Day Pass from Operator

Once a ticket is scanned, it becomes void and the fare scanner will display a red light if the ticket is scanned again.

The 10-Ride Ticket books are no longer available for purchase, but are still honored as valid fare.
