






Memorial Day Service

Additional Precautions at LTD

Beginning Monday, April 27, all vendors and LTD employees will be temperature screened at the beginning of their shift and before entering any LTD facility. Anyone with a temperature of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or higher will be sent home.

Temporary Bus Service Schedule Riders will notice bus schedule adjustments made in **DOWNLOAD ROUTE SCHEDULES**

April. Based on social distancing requirements, LTD limits its 40-foot buses to 15 passengers and 60-foot buses to 20 passengers, which normally carry 50 and 80 passengers, respectively. Some routes will continue to operate with an adjusted-level of service, while other routes are not operating during the current health crisis. All active routes will operate Monday through Saturday with no service on Sundays for any routes.


