With even more great features, such as finding nearby transit stops, easy directions and the ability to mark favorite locations, the free Umo Mobility app makes your journey simple and seamless. Riders who currently use TouchPass can continue to use the TouchPass mobile app until September 30. Tap cards will continue to be valid and riders can load fare through the Umo Mobility app and website. Riders are encouraged to download and try out the Umo Mobility app early, which is available now on the Apple App Store and Google Play Store.

COVID-19 Updates

As part of our health-first approach, LTD encourages all passengers to take the necessary precautions to stay healthy during the COVID-19 pandemic. LTD has adhered to all guidance from health authorities throughout the pandemic response and carefully monitors changes at the federal, state and local levels. Recently released Center for Disease Control (CDC) recommendations allow for people who are fully vaccinated to not wear masks or practice social distancing in many public places, with the exception of public transportation, hospitals, long-term care facilities, and correctional facilities. Passengers riding LTD buses are still required to wear a mask covering their nose and mouth and observe social distancing guidelines according to new recommendations released by the CDC on Thursday, May 13, 2021.
