

WELCOME BACK TO CAMPUS, DUCKS!

LTD and University of Oregon Transportation Services want you to have a seamless commute to campus! UO students and employees have access to a **free bus pass**, valid on EmX and all neighborhood bus routes. When you board the EmX, 79X, or any neighborhood bus route, remember to have your bus pass ready to scan on the Umo app or your tap card. Whether you are new to UO or had a bus pass last academic year, you will need to redeem a new benefit code for an LTD bus pass for this academic year. Beginning September 8, 79X service will now operate from 7:20 a.m. to 6:20 p.m. The evening service from 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. that was funded by the Associated Students of the University of Oregon will no longer operate.



FALL SERVICE CHANGES BEGIN SEPTEMBER 8

Fall service changes take effect on Sunday, September 8, bringing increased frequency and additional trips to many routes. The changes will adjust service levels to meet ridership demand and increase operating efficiency. Many of these service increases are made possible through recruitment of new bus operators. After nine weeks of comprehensive classroom and on-the-road training, LTD bus operators begin safely and confidently navigating routes on their own. Are you interested in driving with LTD? GET YOUR FREE K-12 STUDENT TRANSIT PASS


Did you know that K-12 students in Lane County public, private, charter and home schools can ride the bus for free all year long? Ask your school office about the

free Student Transit Pass at back-toschool registration. If you got your free bus pass last school year, remember to bring your tap card to back-to-school registration to get a bus pass for the 2024-2025 school year loaded onto your card. Students who used the Umo app will show their account info to school staff to get a new pass.

LTD IS YOUR STRESS-FREE RIDE TO THE GAME

Another season of Oregon football kicked off at Autzen Stadium on August 31. Duck fans can avoid traffic and parking hassles by taking the bus to the game. Riding the bus to Autzen Stadium is as easy as 1, 2, 3!

- 1. Purchase fare in the Umo app or at EmX ticket vending machines.
- 2. Ride EmX to Agate Station.
- 3. Travel across the footbridge to Autzen Stadium.

For even more travel options, fans can leave their vehicle at one of LTD's 21 free **Park & Ride locations**, board their neighborhood bus to Eugene or Springfield Stations, then transfer to EmX toward Agate Station. Renting a **PeaceHealth Rides** bike from our partners at Cascadia Mobility is a great option, too!

On days with University of Oregon home football games, detours are in effect on Routes 12, 13, 28, 66, 67, 79X, and 96. Depending on game day traffic, other bus routes may be impacted.


