Bike Friendly, Transit Friendly:

New Self-Service Bike Repair Stations Installed in Springfield

Willamalane and Lane Transit District are making it easier for people to combine biking and transit. Together, we have installed four new self-service bicycle repair stations at key Willamalane facilities throughout Springfield. These stations are free to use and include a bike pump, rack, and tools for common repairs like fixing a flat tire or adjusting brakes.

Bike Repair Station Locations:

- Bob Keefer Center (250 S 32nd St)
- Splash! at Lively Park (6100 Thurston Rd)
- Willamalane Adult Activity Center (215 W C St)
- Willamalane Park Swim Center (1276 G St)

This project supports active transportation and helps remove barriers for people choosing to ride their bikes to catch the bus, visit a park, or attend a community program.

Did you know that K-12 students in Lane County public, private, charter and home schools can ride the bus for free all year long? Ask your school office about the free Student Transit Pass at back to school registration. If you got your free bus pass last school year, remember to bring your tap card to back to school registration to get a bus pass for the 2025-2026 school year loaded onto your card. Students who used the Umo app will show their account info to school staff to get a new pass.

Fall Service Changes Begin Sunday, September 7

Lane Transit District is making updates to improve efficiency and better match ridership needs. Below is a summary of the changes by route.

Here's a preview of some of the changes coming this fall:

- Route 1 will be renamed the Downtown Loop and serve a larger geographic area with more frequent service. Learn more: LTD.org/Downtown-Loop
- Route 36 is expanding to serve Willow Creek Road and 18th Ave. between Bertelsen and Willow Creek.
- Route 41 will serve Bertelsen instead of Danebo.
- Additional trips and timepoint adjustments will also affect Routes 11, 12, 13, 17, 18, 24, 28, 40, 51, 52, 55, 66, 67, 95, and 98.

Coming This Fall: Improved Downtown Eugene Bus Service Pilot


Starting September 7, 2025, Lane Transit District and the City of Eugene are teaming up to launch a two-year pilot that will bring better, more convenient bus service to Downtown Eugene and Midtown. This pilot project, known as the Downtown Loop, is designed to make it easier to travel between key destinations in the downtown core.

The updated route will expand upon LTD's existing Route 1, covering a larger

geographic area and connecting more people to shops, services, and community spaces. It will also run more often—with buses arriving every 30 minutes—and operate later into the evening, offering riders more flexibility throughout the day.

This pilot will run through summer 2027. At that time, LTD will evaluate how the service performed and determine future changes to the route or schedule based on ridership and available funding.

Whether you're headed to work, grabbing dinner, or catching a show, the new **Downtown Loop** is here to keep you connected. Stay tuned for more details this fall.
