Ride the Bus & Bike Share to Oregon Football at Autzen Stadium

Oregon football is back for the 2025 season, and LTD makes it easy to get to Autzen Stadium without the stress of traffic or parking.

Getting to the Game is as Easy as 1, 2, 3:

- 1. Buy your fare in the Umo app or at any EmX ticket vending machine.
- 2. Ride EmX to Agate Station.
- 3. Cross the footbridge straight to Autzen Stadium.

Fans can combine LTD service with



PeaceHealth Rides bike share through Cascadia Mobility for a smooth trip on game day. Ride the bus to Eugene or Springfield Station, then grab a bike to pedal the last stretch; or hop on a bike at

the stadium after the game to shorten your ride back to EmX.

Leave your vehicle at one of LTD's 21 free Park & Ride locations, ride your neighborhood bus to Eugene or Springfield Station, and transfer to EmX toward Agate Station.
