LABOR DAY BUS SERVICE



FALL SERVICE BEGINS SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 10

Three times a year, LTD makes route and schedule adjustments to make bus service more efficient and meet the changing needs of our community. On Sunday, September 10, the third service change of the year takes effect. Behind the scenes, our transportation planners study ridership patterns months in advance to create an operating schedule that meets the demand of our riders.




This Fall, community members can sign up to receive SMS text message alerts from LTD about service alerts and upcoming projects. Stay tuned for details on how to sign up.

GET YOUR FREE K-12 STUDENT TRANSIT PASS

As the new school year kicks off, LTD welcomes students on the bus with the free Student Transit Pass. All K-12 students in public, private, charter, and home schools across Lane County are eligible for the Student Transit Pass, allowing them to ride the bus for free. Students who had a pass last school year should bring their tap card to back-to-school registration or visit their school's office before September 30 to get a bus pass for the 2023-2024 school year. Students who do not have a free bus pass yet can visit their school's office to get a tap card with a Student Transit Pass.

- 2. Ride EmX to Agate Station.
- 3. Travel across the foot bridge to Alton Baker Park and Autzen Stadium.

- Create a Umo account in the Umo app or at UmoPass.com.
- 2. Add money to your Umo account online or at the Customer Service Center.
- 3. Scan your tap card or Umo app each time you board the bus to pay fare using your Umo account balance.
- 4. Continue to pay as you go with Umo. Your Umo account will keep track of how much fare you've paid in a day and month to make sure you get the best value.
